



What is consecutive interpretation? Consecutive interpretation is where the interpreter skillfully takes notes during the speaker's discourse to orally interpret the speech to the target language. The

speaker pauses when they finish a segment or a complete idea to allow the interpreter to convey the message in the target language.

Is consecutive interpretation an onsite or a remote interpreting service? Both. Consecutive interpretation is a type/mode of interpretation that can be applied in-person, where the interpreter is present onsite, or remotely, whether

through video conferencing (Video Remote Interpreting) or over-the-phone interpreting

Consecutive interpreters use shorthand to jot down content during speech. The speaker then pauses upon finishing a complete idea and the interpreter delivers the

What is the difference between Simultaneous Interpretation and Consecutive Interpretation?

speech in the target language. On the other hand, simultaneous interpreters must reproduce speech in real-time; that is, the speaker doesn't pause to allow for interpretation, so original speech and interpretation take place at the same time (simultaneously)

language pair, consecutive interpretation presents itself as a cost-effective type of interpretation that requires no equipment and involves one interpreter per language pair.

When should I use consecutive interpretation services?

As opposed to simultaneous interpretation, consecutive interpretation takes longer time, since the speaker pauses after each passage/complete idea to allow for interpretation. So, for largescale events, such as international conferences, you might consider choosing simultaneous interpretation[AM4].
